## Remarks

Aetea ligulata is characterized by its broad, rounded, horizontal corrugations, rather than the smaller annulations seen in A. ?australis (above), on the erect midsection. It is the larger of the two species found at Erakor Island during this study. Described by Busk (1852b) from the Straits of Magellan and Patagonia, this species has been accorded a circumglobal distribution (Gordon, 1984).
