*Distribution*

*Reteporella graeffei* is a common member of shallow reef faunas throughout the tropical western Pacific from Queensland and the Great Barrier Reef to Japan, ranging westwards through Indo-Malaysia to Sri Lanka and East Africa. It should be noted that the type locality is Fiji, and thus the described geographical range may include some spurious records, referring to species other than *Reteporella graeffei sensu stricto*. In Vanuatu a small fragmentary sample was found at Poanangisu in loose coral debris.
