Remarks

Stylopoma mauritiana is best characterised by: its primary orifice, straight, proximal border with a slit-like median sinus and shallow, denticulate, condyles; its suboral avicularia, proximal to the sinus, extending to the proximo-lateral corner of the orifice, triangular proximally, mandible acutely triangular.

Stylopoma mauritiana is most similar to S. velatum Tilbrook, 2001 in terms of its primary orifice and to S. horarium in terms of its suboral avicularia.

Distribution

Stylopoma mauritiana was originally recorded from Mauritius, New Guinea and the Great Barrier Reef. In the Solomon Islands it was found at Raun Island, Yandina, Mbanika Island, Russell Islands.
